**Prerequisite: Must be at least 21 years of age and student must show proof of passing a MMPI (Minnesota Multi-Phasic Personality Inventory) that was administered by an Oklahoma licensed psychologist.**

#### **Course Description**

Will consist of twelve hours of classroom training that covers:

- Safety
- Nomenclature and Maintenance
- Fundamentals of Marksmanship
- Handgun Handling Skills
- Handgun Presentations/Shooting Positions
- Range Procedures, Tower Commands, and Courses of fire
- Legal Issues

and twenty hours on the firing range.

A score of 100% is required on the safety test before you can get on firing range. 100% attendance is required and you must qualify on firing range for successful completion.

#### **Safety Equipment Needed:**

- Shooting Glasses – Wrap-around or prescription glasses with side panels
- Hearing Protection – Earmuffs or ear plugs (earmuffs give more protection)
- Hat – Ball cap with a bill to keep hot brass from getting behind glasses or down shirt

#### **Cleaning Equipment Needed:**

- Powder Solvent – Hoppes, gun scrubber, etc.
- Gun Oil – Any gun rated protective oil (Not WD 40)
- Cleaning rod and cleaning jag or patch holder
- Cleaning Patches – for caliber of gun you will be using
- Bore Brush – Brass or bronze for caliber of gun you will be using
- Old Tooth Brush – or other small cleaning brush
- Cleaning Rags
- Screwdriver – For revolver or autos with grip screws

#### **Shooting Equipment Needed:**

- Belt – Good quality leather or nylon (either trouser belt that holster attaches to or duty belt)
- Holster – Must fit the particular handgun to be used. Must have retention strap of some kind (thumb snap is the most common and quickest to use)
- Magazine Pouch – Closed top or open top with tension screw
- Magazines (for auto) – Three preferably, two will work, but three is best
- Speed loaders (for revolver) – Need three

#### **Ammunition Needed:**

Minimum of 500 rounds

#### **Firearms Needed:**

Only quality firearms from reputable manufacturers. Caliber does not seem to matter, as it is the placement of the bullet that work, and not what they are hit with.
